**During this 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Our Diocese....We invite you to visit the pilgrimage site at Saints Mary & Joseph, 1225 Mission Road, Sawyer, Minnesota.** See the oldest altar and Stations of the Cross in existence in the Diocese of Duluth and the old log church which is on the National Register of Historic Sites. The Sunday Mass is at 10:30 am. The current church is generally opened between 9-9:30 am. Narrated tours will be conducted after the Sunday Mass beginning June 7 through Labor Day weekend. Visitors in groups of four or more wishing to visit at another time may call Deacon Bryan Bassa at 218-879-6933 or the parish office (509 Sunrise Drive, Carlton, MN 55718) at 218-384-4563 Monday - Thursday 8 am - Noon, and the parish secretary, Betty Lee, will work to arrange for a volunteer to meet you at the date and time of your request. The original painting on the Diocesan prayer card to Saint Kateri can be viewed in the current Church. The original shrine outside has been reconstructed and contains a digital reproduction of the original painting. A statue to Saint Kateri, utilizing the top of the altar of the log church, is located in the current church. You will also be able to enter and view the interior of the log church. They enthusiastically invite all to visit them and celebrate their history as a local church.

A unique learning experience, **Altaration** will help you come to see the Mass and the priesthood in a dramatically new way. **Altaration** is designed to stir thought, create conversation, dispel myths, and inspire your soul to a deep and lasting love for the Mass and fully appreciate its awesome beauty and mystery. Our study of **Altaration** is on **Sunday evenings at 6 pm**. This is the fourth week in our 5-week program but you can join in at any time. It's designed with teens in mind, but all (teens, seniors, and everyone in-between!) are invited to attend, participate, and be transformed.
